

## What is a Flexible Spending Account?

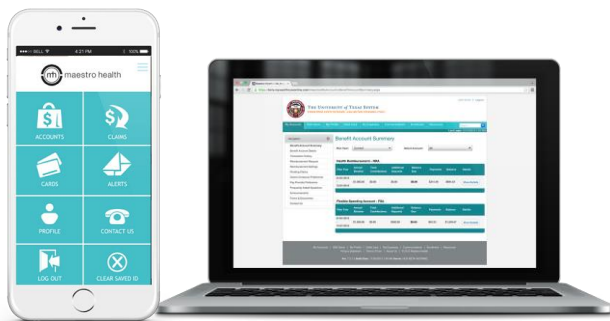
A Flexible Spending Account, or FSA, is an employee benefit that allows you to conveniently save and pay for you and your family's healthcare and dependent day care expenses using tax-free money. There are two accounts. The Healthcare FSA is used for certain qualified out-of-pocket expenses not covered by your health plan. The Dependent Care FSA is used for expenses paid to care for qualified dependents that allows you to work.
